On behalf of Homestead Youth & Family Services, Inc. I am submitting this Letter of Intent to apply to become a CCO with the OHA. Homestead is located in Pendleton, Oregon and intends to serve all of Umatilla County, Oregon. At this point, key potential affiliates include Osoa Therapy but we have not yet solidified partnerships. Further, we anticipate being able to manage *without* limits on capacity.

Currently, Homestead is a direct service provider but does not have a contract with the OHA as a MCO. Homestead is not currently licensed as an insurer with the Oregon Insurance Division but will submit necessary paperwork as is appropriate. Homestead does not have a contract as a Medicare Advantage Plan or expect a contract with the CMS.

Homestead elects the August 1/August 8 application timeline for submitting its Technical and Financial Applications. At this point, Homestead does not intend to submit a Medicare Notice of Intent to Apply to CMS.

I acknowledge that this Letter of Intent is non-binding, except that OHA will consider this Letter of Intent will remain in effect and OHA may rely on it until Homestead changes or withdraws it in accordance with the RFA. Homestead will submit its Technical and Financial Applications on the dates set forth in this letter of Intent to Apply, unless Homestead submits to OHA to change this Letter of Intent to Apply. Homestead understands this Letter of Intent to Apply will be made public.
