



**ATTACHMENT 5 – CCO LETTER OF INTENT TO APPLY
RFA #3402**

FamilyCare has been involved in and supports the Tri-County Medicaid Collaborative's (TCMC) work in creating a CCO in tri-county. We intend to continue to work with the collaborative in developing a community-wide CCO. Because we have a strong commitment to our Medicaid members, we will continue our plans for an independent CCO in the event that the TCMC does not achieve its goal of a community-wide program.

1. Applicant's legal name is FamilyCare, Inc.; headquartered at 825 NE Multnomah, Suite 300, Portland, OR 97232. Key contact is Jeff Heatherington; CEO. jeffh@familycareinc.org

2. FamilyCare's desired service area is all of Clackamas, Multnomah and Washington counties, including contiguous zip codes in Marion county.

3. FamilyCare's affiliate is FamilyCare Health Plans.

4. FamilyCare desires no limit on capacity.

5. FamilyCare currently has an FCHP contract with OHA, which includes Clatsop, Clackamas, Jackson, Josephine, Multnomah, and Washington counties. FamilyCare will seek to remove Clackamas, Multnomah and Washington counties from its FCHP contract service area immediately prior to the effective date of FamilyCare's CCO contract in those counties.

FamilyCare expects the MHO contract to be terminated in Clackamas, Multnomah and Washington counties immediately prior to the effective date of FamilyCare's CCO contract in those counties.

6. FamilyCare is currently licensed as an insurer with the Oregon Insurance Division.

7. FamilyCare has a contract with CMS as a Medicare Advantage plan, through its affiliate, FamilyCare Health Plans.

8. FamilyCare chooses to submit its Technical application on April 30 and its Financial application on May 14.

9. FamilyCare has submitted a Notice of Intent to Apply to CMS. It is attached.

The Applicant acknowledges that this Letter of Intent is non-binding, except that OHA will consider this Letter of Intent will remain in effect and OHA may rely on it until the Applicant changes or withdraws it in accordance with the RFA. The Applicant will submit its Technical and Financial Applications on the dates set forth in this Letter of Intent to Apply, unless Applicant submits to OHA changes to this Letter of Intent to Apply. The Applicant understands this Letter of Intent to Apply will be made public.
